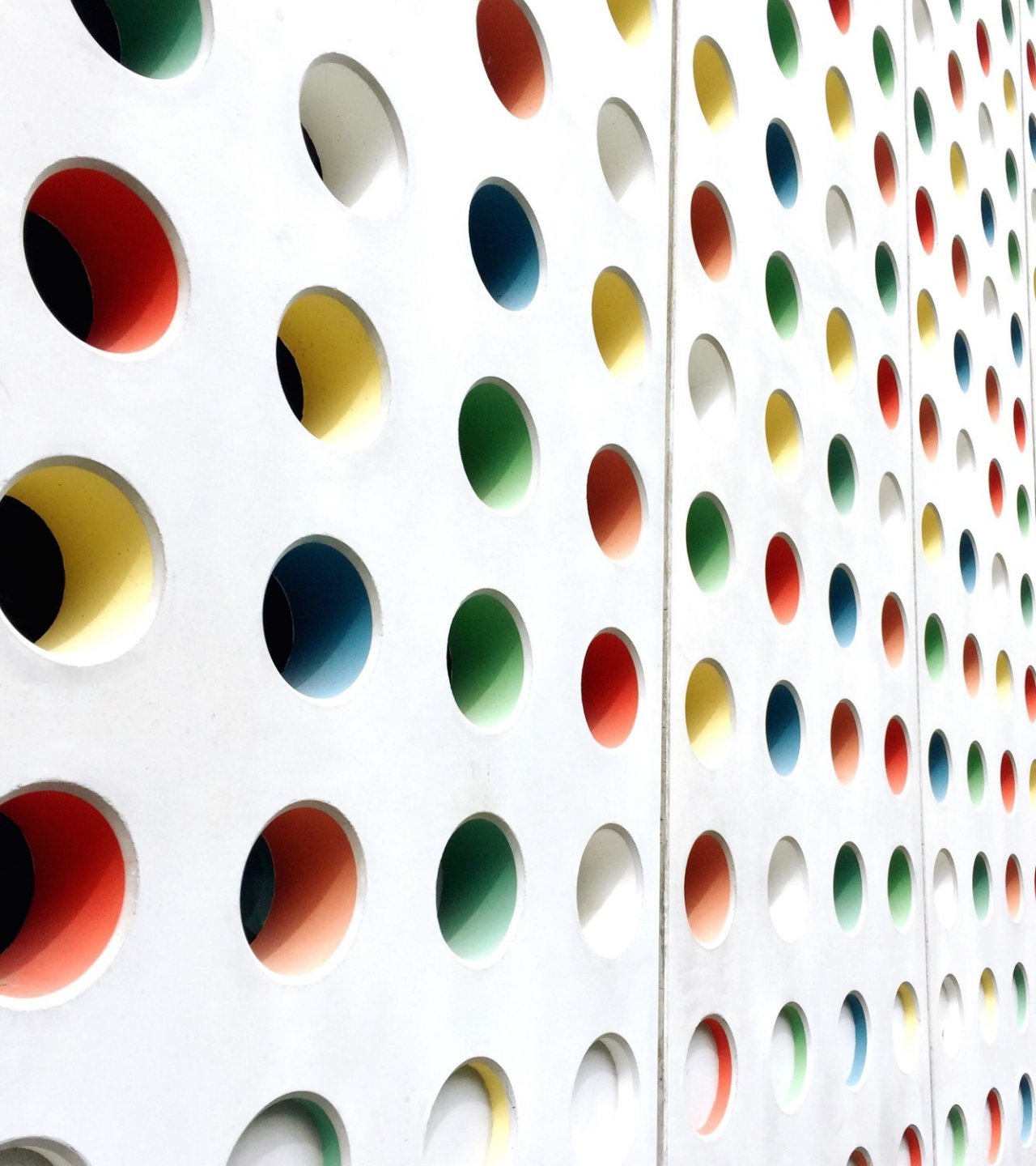




Sanctuary Artwork

The Christ Figure

Location: Chancel, above the altar

Artist: Ejner Rasmussen

Medium: Copper

Description: The twice life-sized figure of Christ. "As one beholds this representation of our Lord with arms outstretched, one is reminded of the way he died upon the cross. The artist has also caught the image of the Christ in the attitude of benediction over his congregation and even of him saying 'Come unto me'."



The Processional Cross

Location: West wall of the chancel

Artist: Hilton Leach

Medium: Silver

Description: "The simple design is contemporary and blends well with the architecture of the church."

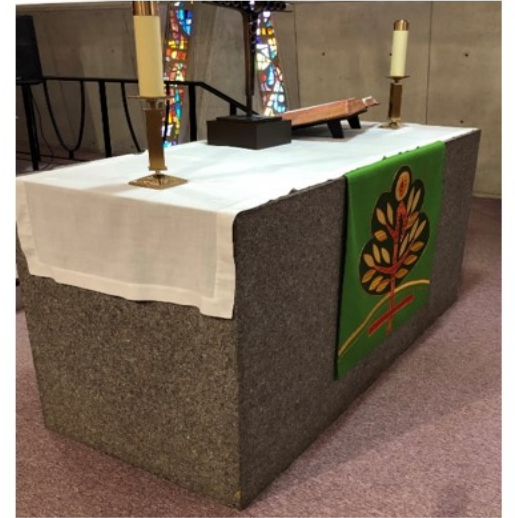


Altars and Baptismal Font

Location: Currently, the large altar is located in the center of the Chancel; the smaller altar is located in the Nave on the east side of the Sanctuary; and the baptismal font is located in the front part of the Nave in the center aisle. These items have been relocated from time to time to meet the needs of the church.

Medium: Georgia granite

Description: The large altar measures 8 feet in length, is 3 feet wide and 3 feet 3 inches high. As it weighs 8 tons, the altar was installed before the walls of the church were erected.
