School Related Fees

- Tuition fees above are based on nine weeks of ECLC Summer Camp.
- Camp begins June 3 and ends on August 2.
- Camp will be closed on July 4 and 5.
- A registration fee of \$50 is due by March 1, 2019
- If payments are not received by deadlines, it could result in the loss of your child's spot, depending on enrollment.
- Anyone wanting to not enroll for the full nine weeks will need to speak with the director or assistant director for reduced rates. Vacation requests will only be approved through March 1, to be included in reduced tuition rates.

Items needed for your child to attend ECLS Summer Camp

A nutritious lunch (except for Pizza Day Friday - which is \$4.00 per child) and closed toed shoes needed daily. Bug spray and sunblock will need to be applied before they arrive. Water play will be on various days throughout the summer. Parents will be notified in advance to bring a bathing suit and towel for their child.
