Sunday, December 8, after worship is the congregational meeting to approve the 2025 spending plan, elect new council and nominating team members, and constitution changes. The most significant change for the constitution is to require fewer members of council. Currently it is a range between 12-15 plus the pastor. We want to change it to the range of 9-12 plus the pastor. This is more in line with the number of members we have at this time. Please plan to stay after worship for the meeting as we need a quorum (20% of members) in order to vote officially.

As most of you know John Beyer moved to Kentucky. He is doing well. He sends his greetings to everyone. One of the ministries he participated in was running our sound system for Sunday morning worship. Rick Barry and Mike Scherr have stepped up to help in his absence but we need another person or two to learn the sound system and to be able to run it. This is vital to Sunday morning worship, so please consider volunteering for this role.

St. Paul would also like to start a Transportation Ministry to be able to offer rides to our members to doctors appointments, get groceries, and other errands. If you are willing to drive people, please let me know. If members are able to use Uber or Lyft, we may be able to help set up those rides. If you would be interested in helping set up the rides for them, please let me know that too.
