

St. Paul has also been praying about a Vision2Action Grant from the Florida-Bahamas Synod. It's a ministry called Building Bridges-a Latino Ministry. The application for the grant is due August 15. We will be applying for it. We won't hear back until November if we receive it to start English and Spanish as secondary language classes that will also include a faith element.



At the end of September all active rostered ministers in the Florida-Bahamas Synod gather in Howey-in-the-Hills for continuing education, worship, and fellowship. This year's theme is "Pursuing Peace, Encouraging Others" based on Romans 14:19 "Let us then pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding." The keynote speaker will be the renowned biblical scholar, the Rev. Dr. Allen Powell. He will delve into biblical images of the Church, consider the meaning of gratitude and generosity in our culture today, and focus on the strategy of stewardship to bring peace and unity to the Church.
